We want to help you maximize the time you have left with your loved ones. We do this by providing comprehensive and compassionate care to manage your symptoms and your pain, enabling you to live out your remaining days with comfort and dignity.

• What is hospice care?

Hospice care focuses on providing comfort and support to patients and their families during the end-of-life stage.

• Who is eligible?

Patients with a life expectancy of six months or less, as determined by a physician, are eligible for hospice care.

• How is hospice care funded?

Hospice care is typically covered by Medicare, Medicaid, and most private insurance plans.

• Do we provide respite care?

Family caregivers often feel physically and emotionally drained. We offer up to 5 days of inpatient respite care, giving you time to rest and recharge. Respite also provides a positive experience for the person receiving care.

Helping you and your family cope with loss

Understanding the importance of emotional support for families, we offer:

- Pre-loss bereavement support that begins as soon as the patient is admitted into our care. We focus on the physical and emotional needs of the family and the caregivers and do all we can to help and support.
- Post-loss bereavement support continues for 13 months after the passing of a patient, supporting families through the grieving process.
